Many animals live alone, but some species live in communities that work together to ensure that they all survive.

### **Orcas**

Orcas are a kind of large dolphin. They live, travel, and hunt within family groups called pods. Each orca pod has around 30 members. Orcas communicate with each other by using their mouths to make whistles and clicks. The sounds made by orcas varies from place to place; this shows that they speak different "languages" in different parts of the ocean.

### **Wolves**

Wolves are very social animals. They live in small family groups called packs. Each pack lives in and defends an area of land. This is their territory. Every wolf in the pack has a job to do, which helps the pack and keeps it safe. For example, the parent wolves are the leaders. They make decisions for the pack, such as where and when to hunt.
